

HARGRAVE VILLAGE HALL

2020 has been a very different year for Hargrave Village Hall.

The Bowls Club and Keep Fit only had a small number of sessions and St Edmund PCC were able to hold a couple of Pop up Pubs and the Cross Country Fun Run before the Hall was closed due to the Covid 19 pandemic.

We were able to start the Hargrave Lottery with the first draw taking place in June 2020. There are currently 50 members. 50% of the quarterly takings are given in prizes with the remainder going to Village Hall funds.

Discussions continued regarding the future of Hargrave Village Hall. It has been impossible to hold a public meeting for villagers but it is hoped that this can be done soon.

In line with other organisations, we have received a number of grants from West Suffolk Council to support businesses that have not been able to be open as usual due to restrictions.

The Hall is managed by a small committee who continue to provide a pleasant, clean and safe meeting place for all. If you would like to join the committee, please let us know.
