

HARGRAVE VILLAGE HALL

The Bowls Club continue to use the Hall on Monday afternoons for 'Social Bowls' which is proving to be popular with numbers increasing. The PCC of St Edmund's Church, Hargrave continues to use the Hall for the annual BBQ and Pop-up Pubs which are a great place to catch up with fellow villagers and enjoy a freshly made woodfired pizza.

The Hall has been used for more private bookings this past year.

The Hargrave Lottery continues with 4 draws each year in March, June, September, and December. There are currently 51 members. 50% of the quarterly takings are given in prizes with the remainder going to Village Hall funds.

Discussions have continued regarding the future of Hargrave Village Hall with a suggestion to build a new Village Hall as well as 10 houses on the field behind the Hall. As this proposition is no longer viable, we move forward, working with the Parish Council to consider other available options.

The Hall is now equipped with Broadband supplied by BT.
